Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-692-4 with Applied Remedial Services, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$290,000, for removal and disposal of hazardous waste materials at the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Health Centers, for the period from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This contract is 100% funded in the Enterprise I Fund. (No rate increase).

**BACKGROUND:**

On March 12, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-692-3 with Applied Remedial Services, Inc., for the period from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, for the provision of removal and disposal of hazardous waste and chemicals for the Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers.
