Subject: Novation Contract #74-190-14 with Mental Health Management I, Inc. (dba Canyon Manor)

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74-190-14 with Mental Health Management I, Inc. (dba Canyon Manor), a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$209,751, to provide mental health subacute care and treatment services, for the period from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2014, in an amount not to exceed \$104,875.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Mental Health Realignment. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population in that it provides long-term care for adults with serious mental illness who require skilled nursing inpatient psychiatric care.

In January 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved Novation Contract #74-190-13 with Mental Health Management I, Inc. (dba Canyon
