FISCAL IMPACT:

On January 7, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-604-9 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-604-10) with Michael Gynn, M.D., to provide general surgery services including consultation, training, on-call, medical and/or surgical procedures, for patients at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers (CCRMC), for the period from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. Approval of Contract #26-604-11 will allow the Contractor to continue to provide general
