Subject: Police Dispatching Services

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Sheriff-Coroner, or designee, to execute a contract amendment with the Town of Moraga, including mutual indemnification, to pay the County an amount not to exceed \$875,000 to provide police dispatching services and limited warrant services, effective April 1, 2015, for the period July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2017.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

No net County cost. \$875,000 revenue over five and one-half years.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Office of the Sheriff will provide police dispatching services, limited to law enforcement activity for the Town of Moraga. Services will include dispatching, call-taking, sending and receiving voice and data traffic, answering emergency (911) calls and warrant checks to aid the the town's Police Department.
