Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #74-459-2 with Michael Fidler, M.D., a self-employed individual, in an amount not to exceed \$116,480, to provide outpatient psychiatric services for mentally ill adults in West County for the period from April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by CCHP Enterprise Fund III, offset by third-party billing.

BACKGROUND:

For a number of years the County has contracted with Medical, Dental and Mental Health Specialists to provide specialized professional services, which are not otherwise available.

On February 25, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-459-1 with Michael Fidler, M.D. for the provision of
