FISCAL IMPACT:

BACKGROUND:

The Health Services Department is requesting three Community Health Worker II positions assigned to the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program within the Public Health Division to improve efficiency in serving its clients. WIC Program provides checks for nutrition, nutrition education, referrals to health and human services and breastfeeding support. Duties of Community Health Workers include providing assistance to Home Economists and Public Health Nutritionists in health education and program enrollment. Utilizing this classification will significantly reduce "wait times' for clients as Community
