<u>RECOMMENDATION(S):</u>

CONTINUE public hearing as an open public hearing for the Keller Canyon Landfill Permit Review to July 21, 2015 to consider approving new and modified conditions of approval for the Keller Canyon Landfill land use permit; and to consider related actions under the California Environmental Quality Act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Land Use Permit (LUP) review has no impact to the County General Fund. Keller Canyon Landfill (KCL) Company is responsible for providing reimbursement for the County's staff costs associated with the Permit Review process.
