RECOMMENDATION(S):

CONTINUE to April 14, 2015 the Board's consideration of proposed Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnerships allocations totaling \$5,166,420, as recommended by the Affordable Housing Finance Committee.

BACKGROUND:

The Affordable Housing Finance Committee (AHFC) is a Board-appointed committee that develops funding recommendations for the Board concerning the allocation of federal funds for affordable housing development.

The AHFC met on March 16, and March 30, 2015 to develop funding recommendations for CDBG-Housing, and HOME funds. The AHFC recommendations will be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors on April 14, 2015.
