For a number of years, the County has contracted with registries to provide temporary qualified physicians to work as temporary physicians to ensure appropriate medical physician and inpatient psychiatry staff coverage at CCRMC. On March 25, 2014 the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-395-16 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-395-17) with LocumTenens.com, LLC for the provision of temporary physician services CCRMC for the period from March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015.
