Subject: Contract #26-395-19 with LocumTenens.com, LLC

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-395-19 with LocumTenens.com, LLC, a limited liability company, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000, to provide temporary physician services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers (CCRMC), for the period from March 1, 2015 through February 29, 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% by Health Service Department Enterprise Fund I. As appropriate, patient and/or third-party payors will be billed for services. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

For a number of years, the County has contracted with registries to provide temporary qualified physicians to work as temporary physicians to ensure appropriate medical physician and inpatient psychiatry staff coverage at CCRMC. On March 25, 2014 the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-395-16 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-395-17) with LocumTenens.com, LLC for the provision of temporary physician services CCRMC for the period from March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015.
