Subject: Amendment #26-654-10 with Bay Area Tumor Institute

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-654-10 with Bay Area Tumor Institute, a non-profit corporation, effective April 1, 2015, to amend Contract #26-654-9, to increase the payment limit by \$750,000, from \$650,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,400,000, with no change in the original term of August 1, 2014 through July 31, 2015.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This is a contingency fee contract Amendment. Contractor receives a percentage of the amount it collects on behalf of the County.

**BACKGROUND:**

On September 9, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-654-9 with Bay Area Tumor Institute, for the period from August 1, 2014 through July 31, 2015, for the provision of pharmaceutical drug recovery reimbursement services of products provided to indigent
