RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a temporary permit for ingress and egress purposes with Chevron U.S.A., Inc., effective March 31, 2015 through December 31, 2015, for the North Richmond Pump Station Storm Water Diversion Project. (Project No.: 7517-6W7246)

BACKGROUND:

The County is preparing for construction of the North Richmond Pump Station Storm Water Diversion Project (Project).

In order to move forward with Project construction, the County needs a temporary permit for ingress and egress (Permit) to occupy a 30-foot-wide portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 561-110-040 (Property). The Property the County needs to occupy and use is owned by Chevron U.S.A., Inc. (Property Owner) and is adjacent to and west of the County's pump station property.
