Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #27-662-6 with Yaron Friedman, M.D., Inc., a corporation, effective May 1, 2015, to amend Contract #27-662-5, to increase the payment limit by \$80,000, from \$400,000 to a new payment limit of \$480,000, with no change in the original term of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016.

On January 31, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-662-5 with Yaron Friedman, M.D., Inc., for the provision of Obstetrics and Gynecology services for Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP) patients and county recipients, for the period from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016. At the time of negotiations, the payment limit was based on target levels of utilization. However, the utilization during the
