Subject: Amendment #26-732-6 with Christopher John Voscopoulos, M.D.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-732-6 with Christopher John Voscopoulos, M.D., a self-employed individual, effective May 1, 2015, to amend Contract #26-732-3 (as amended by #26-732-4, and #26-732-5), to provide additional services, and increase the payment limit by \$285,000, from \$1,245,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,530,000, with no change in the original term of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On September 24, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-732-3 (as amended by Amend-ment Agreements #26-732-4 through #26-732-5) with Christopher John Voscopoulos, M.D. for the provision of anesthesiology services and critical care provider at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers
