Subject: Contract Amendment Agreement #24-979-28 with Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #24-979-28 with Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc. (dba Bay Area Addiction Research and Treatment), a corporation, effective May 1, 2015, to increase the total payment limit by \$508,992, from \$4,478,510, to a new total amount of \$4,987,602 with no change in the original term of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment is funded 50% by Federal Drug Medi-Cal and 50% State Drug Medi-Cal. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On October 21, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #24-979-27 with Addiction Research and Treatment, Inc. (dba Bay Area Addiction Research and Treatment), for the period from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015, for the provision of methadone
