FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract payment limit is funded by Hospital Enterprise I Funds in an amount not to exceed \$390,000 for inpatient mental health services. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

Santa Clara County Department of Correction provides Acute Inpatient Mental Health Services to inmates housed at its facility, including, but not limited to, psychiatric, psychological, and counseling services; physician and nursing services, ancillary services, including laboratory tests or medications; and routine medical and dental services.
