## **BACKGROUND:**

On June 3, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-347-22 (as amended by Amendment Agreements #26-347-23, and #26-347-24), with Cross Country Staffing, Inc., for the provision of temporary medical staffing services including nursing, therapy, radiology, and pharmacy services at CCRMC for the period from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. Approval of Contract #26-347-25 will allow Contractor to continue providing temporary medical and other staffing services through June 30, 2016.
