### BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

On October 7, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-464-1 with John R. Rostkowski, M.D., for the provision of outpatient psychiatric care services to patients in Central County for the period from October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015.

Approval of Contract #74-464-2 will allow the Contractor to continue providing outpatient psychiatric care services to adults in Central County, through September 30, 2016.
