FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this Agreement will result no change in the original amount of \$124,100, payable to County, for the West County's Adult Interim Housing Program, Philip Dorn Respite Center in Richmond through September 29, 2015. (No County match).

BACKGROUND:

The Health Services Department seeks continuous funding to provide interim housing, treatment, and other services for homeless veterans that access the Philip Dorn Respite Center through the West County emergency shelter program. Each year the shelters provide interim housing and support services to over 75 homeless veterans of Contra Costa County.
