RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #26-445-12 with Aaron K. Hayashi, M.D., Inc., a corporation, effective June 1, 2015, to amend Contract #26-445-10 to increase the payment limit by \$111,000, from \$1,800,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,911,000, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This amendment is funded 100% by Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On May 13, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-445-10 with Aaron K. Hayashi, M.D., Inc. for the provision of radiology services, including, but not limited to, clinical coverage, consultation, on-call, supervision and interpretation of CT Scans, MRIs, Ultrasounds, invasive procedures and plain films at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center (CCRMC), for the period from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017. At the time of negotiations, the payment limit was based on target levels of utilization. However, the utilization during the term of the agreement
