BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

during the budget period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015. The Board approved an amendment to the agreement on March 11, 2014 to amend the facility repair plan to include additional Children's Center sites: Fairgrounds (Antioch), George Miller (Concord), Balboa (Richmond), Lavonia Allen (Bay Point), Los Arboles (Oakley). The board approved a second amendment on May 5, 1015 to further amend the facility repair plan to include additional projects to Balboa Children's Center (Richmond) and Lavonia Allen Children's Center (Bay Point). The projects replaced a modular building roof at Balboa and completed ground leveling and playground area turf replacement at Lavonia Allen (Bay Point).

This third amendment seeks to amend the facility repair plan to include an additional project at Lavonia Allen (Bay Point). The project is to install an exterior surveillance system. These requests were made to provide a safer environment for the children served at those centers. The amendment request came post contract end date.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If not approved, County will not receive funds to completed necessary facility repairs.
