Subject: Agreement #15-0305-SA Nursery Inspection Program

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Agricultural Commissioner, or designee, to execute Agreement #15-0305-SA Nursery Inspection Program with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to reimburse the department in an amount not to exceed \$1106 to provide labor and equipment necessary to perform nursery inspections and enforcement activities within the county for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. There is no county match of funds nor does it involve grant money.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This action provides reimbursement, not to exceed \$1106 from California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) for departmental expenses incurred during the agreement period for visual surveys of nurseries and to enforce all laws and regulations pertaining to nursery stock, including licensing requirements in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the CDFA and the California Agricultural Commissioner and Sealers Association (CACASA) entitled "State-County Nursery Inspection Program. Approval of this agreement will provide revenue for the Department to fulfill the requirements of the agreement. Agreement is fully funded by the CDFA. No county match of funds is required nor does this involve grant money.
