RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #74-341-89(6) with Lesley Cantor, MFT, an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, to provide Medi-Cal specialty mental health services for the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 50% State General Fund and 50% Federal Medi-Cal Funds. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On August 13, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #74-341-89(3) [as amended by Contract Amendment Agreements #74-341-89(4) and #74-341-89(5)] with Lesley Cantor, MFT, for the provision of Medi-Cal specialty mental health services, for the period from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015. Approval of Contract #74-341-89(6) will allow Contractor to continue providing services through June 30, 2017.
