Subject: Contract #23-226-12 with Boehm and Associates

**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #23-226-12 with Boehm and Associates, a partnership, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 to provide consulting and technical assistance on worker's compensation laws and third party liability recovery for the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The Contractor receives 20% of the amounts collected on accounts identified by the County and referred to Contractor; and 25% of the amount collected on accounts identified and recovered by Contractor.

This contract is funded 100% by third-party revenue from collection activities. (No rate increase)

**BACKGROUND:**

In June 2013, the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed, Contract #23-226-9 (as amended by Contract Amendment Agreements #23-226-10 and #23-266-11) with Boehm and Associates for the provision of consultation
