### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

ADOPT Position Adjustment Resolution No.21705 to add one (1) Registered Nurse-Experienced Level (VWXD) position (\$7,305-\$8,142)in the Contra Costa Health Plan division of the Health Services Department.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Upon approval, this action will cost approximately \$156,770 annually with benefits, including \$34,687 in pension costs. Costs will be funded by CCHP Enterprise Fund II. (100%)

### **BACKGROUND:**

Due to the exponential growth in Contra Costa Health Plan membership, Providers in the CCHP network have increased 20%, in turn increasing the number of site reviews performed. This Registered Nurse position would be responsible for performing: Facility Site Reviews (FSR), Physical Accessibility Review Surveys (PARS) and Medical Record Review (MRR) using the Medi-Cal Managed Care Tools at each Primary Care, OB/GYN, High Bolume Specialty and non-accredited facility for CCHP's Provider Relations unit. This individual would also function as a community provider liaison for the health plan
