Approval of submission of funding will result in grant amount, up to \$990,000 in funding, from the California Department of Public Health, Tobacco Control Program. No County match required.


### **BACKGROUND:**

While 87% percent of Contra Costans are non-smokers, smoking related diseases cost over \$228 million in excess healthcare in the County, and many are exposed to second hand smoke. Specific populations continue to be targeted by the Tobacco Industry, and these populations are disproportionately affected by tobacco-related health disparities.
