Subject: APPROVE a Purchase order with Hajoca Corp. (dba Heieck Supply Co.)

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Purchasing Agent, or designee, to execute, on behalf of the Public Works Director, a purchase order with Hajoca Corporation (dba Heieck Supply Co.) in an amount not to exceed \$170,000, for plumbing parts and equipment, for the period of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This cost is to be funded through Public Works Facilities Maintenance Services budget. (100% General Fund)

BACKGROUND:

Public Works Facilities Maintenance Services Division conducted a Bidsync bid soliciting a vendor for plumbing parts and equipment. These parts are typically items used in plumbing repairs and improvements. Posted as Bidsync Bid # "Plumbing Parts", Heieck Supply and General Plumbing were awarded this commodity. The original request was for two years with three possible one year extensions. This request represents the second and third of these
