### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute Contract Amendment No. 2 to the Consulting Services Agreement (CSA) with Ghirardelli Associates, Inc. (Ghirardelli), effective June 1, 2015, to increase the payment limit by \$92,000 to a new payment limit of \$442,000, for construction management services for the San Pablo Dam Road Walkability Project, Project No. 0662-6R4051

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This project, including the CSA, is funded by 44% Transportation for Livable Communities Funds, 16% Proposition 1B Funds, and 40% Local Road Funds.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The Public Works Director, or designee, executed a CSA, dated August 12, 2014, with Ghirardelli for construction management services for the San Pablo Dam Road Walkability Project.
