BACKGROUND

For over 21 years, the Housing Authority of the County of Contra Costa has contracted with the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Department to provide two full-time sheriff deputies for additional community-oriented policing duties at the Bayo Vista and Las Deltas housing developments. The deputies focus on deterring drug-related activities, eliminating violent
