BACKGROUND

For the past 21 years, the Housing Authority of the County of Contra Costa ("Housing Authority") has contracted with the City of Pittsburg to provide one full-time police officer for additional community-oriented policing duties at the El Pueblo Housing Development. The officer focuses on eliminating drug-related activities, eliminating violent crimes, and working closely with residents to provide services beyond those normally offered by the
