Subject: 2016 Food Services Agreement with Little Angels Country Day School LLC

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment & Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Little Angels Country Day School LLC to pay the county an amount not to exceed \$39,000 to provide food services to the childcare program at Little Angels Country Day School for the period February 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No net County costs.

Little Angels Country Day School has agreed to reimburse the County, up to the limits of the California Child and Adult Food Program, for food service expenses related to this contract. The County will provide breakfast, lunch and snack to up to 50 children at the rate of \$3.54 per day per child.

BACKGROUND:

Little Angels Country Day School preschool program offers Head Start and State Preschool program services through contract with the Community Services Bureau (CSB). The preschool provides services to low-income children in East Contra Costa County. CSB will
