BACKGROUND:

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) invited County Welfare Departments (CWDs) to participate in an online employment and wage verification service agreement. CDSS entered into an agreement with Equifax/TALX Corporation aka The Work Number to provide participating counties with online employment and wage verification services. That agreement allows CDSS to provide an online employment and wage verification system based on client social security numbers to all 58 CWDs. The service is at no cost to the CWDs.
