## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment Agreement #25-066-8 with Shelter Inc. of Contra Costa County, a non-profit corporation, effective April 1, 2016, to amend Contract #25-066-7, to increase the payment limit by \$366,509, from \$1,209,417 to a new payment limit of \$1,575,926, with no change in the original term of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This amendment is funded 11% Housing and Urban Development; and 89% CalWorks Housing Support Grant to EHSD. (No rate increase)

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On July 7, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #25-066-7 with Shelter Inc. of Contra Costa County for the provision of supportive housing services for homeless families, for the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
