BACKGROUND:

The Department, though the Community Services Bureau, manages a childcare operation that includes Early Head Start and State General Childcare Development programs. In order to reach a wider community, the Bureau sub-contracts with community based agencies to provide services. This contract is to further the reach of the above mentioned programs by providing 20 program slots for State General Childcare and 20 program slots for Early Head Start Program enhancement.

This amendment is to pass through a cost of living adjustment provided by California Department of Education.

CONSEQUENCE OF NEGATIVE ACTION:

If not approved, County will not be able to more widely distribute childcare availability through partnership with community based agencies.
