Subject: Contract #26-800-2 with John Roark, M.D.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-800-2 with John Roark, M.D., an individual, in an amount not to exceed \$291,800, to provide gastroenterology services at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Health Centers (CCRMC) for the period from May 1, 2016 through April 30, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (Rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

In June 2015 the County Administrator approved and the Purchasing Services Manager executed Contract #26-800 (as amended by Amendment Agreement #26-800-1) with John Roark, M.D., for the provision of gastroenterology services including but not limited to: clinic coverage, consultation, on-call coverage, training and medical procedures at CCRMC for the period from May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016. Approval of Contract #26-800-2 will allow Contractor to continue providing gastroenterology services through April 30, 2018.
