BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

agreement is to provide San Diego State University Foundation for its Women, Infant and Children Dietitian (WIC) Internship Program, dietitian students with the opportunity to integrate academic knowledge with applied skills at progressively higher levels of performance and responsibility. Supervised fieldwork experience for students is considered to be an integral part of both educational and professional preparation. The Health Services Department can provide the requisite field education, while at the same time, benefitting from the students' services to patients.
