**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute Contract #26-790-1 with the Regents of the University of California, on behalf of the University of California, San Francisco, including mutual indemnification, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000, for the provision of endocrinology services for patients at Contra Costa Regional Medical and Health Centers, for the period from February 1, 2016 through January 31, 2017.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Contract is funded 100% Enterprise Fund I Budget.

**BACKGROUND:**

Due to lengthy negotiations, the Contract was not renewed in a timely manner but the Contractor agreed to continue providing services to CCRMC in good faith.
