BACKGROUND:

The Office of the Sheriff will provide law enforcement services for special events such as gun and car shows (exclusive of the County Fair) at the County Fairgrounds in Antioch. The contract includes mutual indemnification of both Contra Costa County and the 23rd District Agriculture Association for the duration of the agreement. The Office has provided law enforcement services to the 23rd District Agriculture Association for several years and has included appropriate revenue estimates and appropriations in the 2016/17 budget related to this contract.
