BACKGROUND:

Facilities Services is responsible for fencing installation and repairs at County facilities. Due to increased use during the past months, the department has exhausted the original dollar value of the contract. To complete the current scheduled projects, Public Works is requesting an amendment to increase the value of the contract.
