BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

At the time of negotiations, the payment limit was based on target levels of utilization. However, the utilization during the term of the agreement was higher than originally anticipated. At the request of the County, the Contractor agreed to provide additional service hours due to an increase in service volume. Approval of Contract Amendment Agreement #26-445-13 will allow the Contractor to provide additional hours of radiology services at CCRMC through June 30, 2017.
