ADOPT Position Adjustment Resolution No. 21868 to add one (1) Secretary - Advanced Level (J3TG) position (\$3,627-\$4,643) in the Contra Costa Health Plan division of the Health Services Department.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Upon approval, the costs associated with this action will be approximately \$95,038 annually with benefits, including \$19,779 in pension costs. Costs will be funded by CCHP Enterprise Fund II. (100%)

BACKGROUND:

A Secretary - Advanced Level position is needed to provide administrative support to the Case Management unit of the Contra Costa Health Plan (CCHP). Duties to include: taking minutes at meetings, handling/routing calls, scheduling meetings for the unit manager and director, timely processing of mandated Medi-Cal transportation benefits, and assisting with care coordination. Mandated requirements are for CCHP to follow up with members who were authorized transportation to verify transportation needs were met.
