**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute a contract with Steve Gray, dba Steve Gray Consulting and Training, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, to provide domestic violence consultation services for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2018. (10% County; 45% State; 45% Federal)

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

\$100,000: Administrative Overhead (10% County; 45% State; 45% Federal)

**BACKGROUND:**

This Domestic Violence (DV) consultant will provide domestic violence case-specific consultation, guidance, and support to Employment and Human Services Department Children and Family Services (CFS) staff, enhancing the collaboration between CFS and other agencies addressing domestic violence and developing interventions which include safety plans for family members affected by violence. Services include assisting with lethality assessments, resource information, interfacing between CFS and other agencies, assisting CFS staff on home visits, ongoing CFS staff domestic violence training, developing protocols, procedures, training materials and assessment tools for staff use, and
