Janice R. Jackson, Tommy Jackson v. County of Contra Costa, et al., CCC Superior Court Case No. C13-01411. On May 10, 2016, the Board approved settlement of this medical malpractice lawsuit. Settlement in the amount of \$55,000, inclusive of attorneys fees and costs, was authorized in closed session by unanimous vote of all five members present. The settlement agreement was fully executed on May 19, 2016. The funding source is the Risk Management Medical Malpractice Internal Service Fund.
