## **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Novation Contract #74–358–7 with Contra Costa Crisis Center, a non-profit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$301,636 to provide Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Prevention and Early Intervention services for the period from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. This Contract includes a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2017 in an amount not to exceed \$150,818.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Mental Health Services Act. (Rate increase)

## **BACKGROUND:**

This Contract meets the social needs of County's population by providing a nationally-certified 24-hour suicide prevention hotline that lowers the risk of suicide at a time when people are most vulnerable, enhances safety and connectedness for suicidal individuals, and builds a bridge to community resources for at-risk persons.

#74 358-6 with Contra Costa Crisis Center, for the period from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016, which included a six-month automatic extension through December 31, 2016 for the provision of MHSA Prevention and Early Intervention services. Approval of Novation Contract #74–358–7 replaces the automatic extension under the prior Contract and allows the Contract to continue providing services through June 30, 2017.
