RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Contract Amendment/Extension Agreement #23-392-9 with the Rodeo-Hercules Fire Protection District, a public agency, effective June 30, 2016, to amend Contract #23-392-8, to increase the Contract Payment Limit by \$264,012 from \$88,004 to a new total payment limit of \$352,016, for the provision of first responder paramedic services and to extend the termination date from June 30, 2016 to June 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Amendment/Extension Agreement is funded 100% CSA EM 1 (Measure H) reflects an increase of \$264,012. (No rate increase).

BACKGROUND:

County Service Area EM-1 was established in 1989 to provide enhanced Emergency Medical Services, including rapid paramedic-staffed ambulance response, to the residents of Contra Costa County.
