

On August 18, 2015, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-140 with East Bay Audiologists, a professional corporation, for the provision of audiology services, including hearing evaluations, hearing aid evaluations, fitting, dispensing and procurement of hearing aids and supplies at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers (CCRMC), for the period from September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2017. At the time of negotiations, the payment limit was based on target levels of utilization. However, the
