Subject: Approve Agreement #28-884 with Sutter East Bay Hospitals

### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Health Services Director, or designee, to execute on behalf of the County, Agreement #28-884 with Sutter East Bay Hospitals, a non-profit organization, to pay the County an amount not to exceed \$10,000 to support microbiological testing services for Sutter Delta Medical Center at the Contra Costa County Public Health Laboratory, for the period from June 1, 2016 through May 31, 2018.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Agreement will result in funding from Sutter East Bay Hospitals in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for Public Health Laboratory services. (No County match required)

### **BACKGROUND:**

Under this agreement #28-884, Sutter East Bay Hospitals agree to pay the County to perform microbiological testing services to Sutter Delta Medical Center, as needed, and on a fee for services basis for the period from June 1, 2016 through May 31, 2018. This Agreement includes mutual indemnification.
