Subject: Trash and Abandoned Waste Cleanup and Removal Contract with Debri-Tech, Inc. Project #7517-WO7078

RECOMMENDATION(S):

APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a contract amendment with Debri-Tech, Inc., to increase the payment limit from \$500,000 to a new payment limit of \$1,000,000, to provide as-needed assistance with trash and abandoned waste cleanup and removal for the Contra Costa County Watershed Program (CWP), with no change to the original term of August 1, 2015 through July 31, 2018, Countywide.

FISCAL IMPACT:

100% Stormwater Utility Assessment Revenue Funds.

BACKGROUND:

The CWP requires as-needed assistance with trash and abandoned waste cleanup and related removal activities in order to remain in compliance with Contra Costa County's stormwater NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit from the California Regional Water Quality Control Board(s).
