Subject: Contract #26-856-31 with Diablo Pulmonary Medical Group, Inc.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #26-856-31 with Diablo Pulmonary Medical Group, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$227,700, to provide pulmonary disease services for patients at Contra Costa Regional Medical Center and Contra Costa Health Centers (CCRMC), for the period from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2019.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This Contract is funded 100% Hospital Enterprise Fund I. (No rate increase)

BACKGROUND:

On October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #26-856-30 with Diablo Pulmonary Medical Group, Inc., for the provision of pulmonary disease services, including, but not limited to: clinical coverage, consultation, training, on-call and surgical procedures, for patients at CCRMC for the period from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2016. Approval of Contract #26-856-31 will allow Contractor to continue providing pulmonary disease services at CCRMC, through September 30, 2019.
