**RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Approve and authorize the Health Services Director, or his designee, to execute, on behalf of the County, Contract #27-319-3 with Diablo Valley Pediatric Medical Group, Inc., a corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000, to provide pediatric primary care services to Contra Costa Health Plan members, for the period from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2018.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Contract is funded 100% Contra Costa Health Plan (Health Plan) Enterprise Fund II. (No rate increase)

**BACKGROUND:**

The Health Plan has an obligation to provide certain specialized professional health care services for its members under the terms of their Individual and Group Health Plan membership contracts with the County. On September 23, 2014, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract #27-319-2, with Diablo Valley Pediatric Medical Group, Inc., for the provision of pediatric primary care services to Contra Costa Health Plan members, for the period from September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2016.
